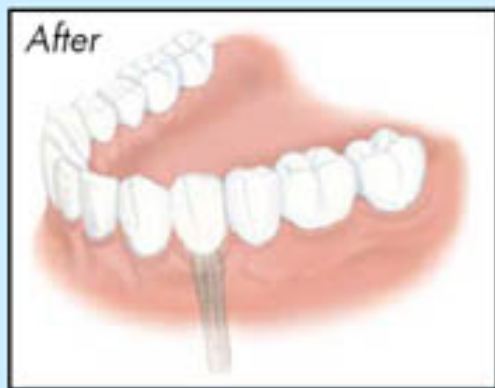


What is a dental implant?

- It is made by titanium and shaped like a screw.
- Placed in the jawbone it serves as a secure root for the new tooth.
- Restorations such as crowns, bridges or dentures can be attached.



If one tooth is missing ...



A single crown on an implant will restore your chewing function and natural appearance.

If several teeth are missing ...



A bridge or crowns supported by several implants will restore your function and looks.

What are the alternatives to dental implants?



Bridge with the supporting teeth cut down.



Partial prosthesis supported by neighboring teeth.

How do dental implant supported teeth differ from a conventional prosthesis?

- Function, look and feel like natural teeth.
- Allow you to speak, smile and eat with confidence.
- Are comfortable and stay in place.
- No damage to neighboring teeth.
